

Tasting Notes: Rich and complex are the two best words to sum up this wine. Dried blueberries, blackberries, white pepper and floral qualities are the first things to come out of the glass. Once delivered to the palate, there is a whole new world of flavors to experience. A medley of red and blue fruits, vanilla, and a touch of salinity to name a few. Upfront acidity balanced by velvety, chalky tannins create a beautiful wine that any glass would be lucky to house.

"Lastly, the 2022 Syrah John Sebastiano Vineyard comes from a site on the eastern end of the Sta. Rita Hills and was destemmed and raised in one-third new barrels for 17 months. Ripe red and blue fruits, cracked black pepper, sappy flowers, violets, and some Cornas-like gaminess all emerge from this beauty, and it's fabulous on the palate, with medium to full-bodied richness, a pure, layered mouthfeel, ripe yet building tannins, and a great finish. It's a brilliant Syrah to drink any time over the coming decade."
