


2023 JOHN SEBASTIANO VINEYARD PINOT NOIR

This is the wine that can disguise itself as an experience in fine-dining. Elderberries and lavender coat the body of this wine, which flows effortlessly throughout the palate, leaving a trace of lingering acidity

and fine chalkiness.

"Black raspberries, spicy wood, flowers, and graphite all emerge from the 2023 Pinot Noir John Sebastiano Vineyard, which was fermented with 25% whole clusters and aged a total of 17 months in 28% new French oak. Medium-bodied and beautifully balanced, it has a pure, layered, and polished mouthfeel, with fine tannins and integrated acidity. It's a classy, seamless, and incredibly impressive Pinot Noir that I love even today, though it should be even better with another year or two in bottle and drink brilliantly through 2033. Drink 2025-2033."
